Fullersburg Woods Salt Creek Improvements

EWRI and the Sustainability Committee have arranged for a presentation by Deanna Doohaluk of The Conservation Foundation about improvements to Salt Creek in DuPage County to restore the creek to its natural condition. Part of that work was the removal of the low head dam at Graue Mill in Oak Brook, IL. This work improves water quality, provides aquatic habitat, and encourages a more diverse fish population.
